Precautions after surgery: PLEASE follow for 7 days - 10 days for cataract surgery / 14 days - 21 days for glaucoma surgery and combined cataract and glaucoma surgery.

PLEASE AVOID CROWDED AREAS AND ALL NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVEL

LEASE	A AVOID CROWDED AREAS AND ALL NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVEL
1.	Please <u>AVOID</u> head bath; <u>NO</u> water or soap in the eye
	Please wipe GENTLY below the eye after applying eyedrops; other eye may also water
	Please wipe the face with a wet towel, AVOIDING the eye
	Please <u>DO NOT</u> rub the eye
	Please sleep on the other side or straight.
	Please use the plastic cap at bed-time (after washing the cap with soap water and drying it)
2.	Please AVOID heavy physical activity, including bending and lifting of heavy weight/s and physical
	closeness with your spouse/partner
3.	You can continue your <u>USUAL</u> diet (diabetics must follow a diabetic diet)
4.	Sometimes the doctor may place a BANDAGE CONTACT LENS – you will be informed if one has
	been placed. If this falls off, please DO NOT try to re-insert in the eye.

	Please make sure your daily motions are free and clear
5.	Please make sure you have no sneeze or cough

6.	Ladies and gentlemen please AVOID kitchen work
	Gentlemen please AVOID wet shave (that is please do not splash water)
7.	If you have the following symptoms, alone or combined with each other, then these might be an
	indication of danger or trouble
	- Pain in the operated eye, ONLY if it does not settle down within 2 hours of tablets prescribed
	- Increasing redness of the operated eye
	- Worsening of vision in the operated eye
